MS Access & MS Excel Databases

The process quoted below relate to databases purchased for research purposes (i.e. those who will not be making commercial use of the database). Additional data sets

The additional data held by the PPDB team covers:

- Soil degradation: The more detailed data covers DT50 by soil type, pH and organic carbon for both lab and field studies (where such data is available).
- Soil adsorption: The more detailed data includes K_{oc}/K_{foc} plus related parameters, by soil type (sand/silt/clay distribution as well as structure type), pH and organic carbon content.
- Plant matrix degradation: The more detailed data includes DT50 by crop/plant/tree type and matrix (fruit, leaves, foliage, rind, peel, tuber, etc.).

This data can be purchased either in a stand-alone format or as an addition to the full PPDB (at a 40% discount), so:
